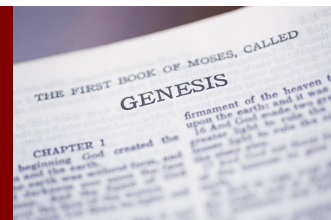
Great follow-up from our Job Search Seminar in August, 2011
