*Philippians 1:27-30*

9. “Jesus has many who love his kingdom in heaven, but few who bear his cross. He has many who desire comfort, but few who desire suffering. He finds many to share his feast, but few his fasting. All desire to rejoice with him, but few are \_\_\_\_\_ to suffer for his sake.” Thomas a Kempis
